



## VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION

- Vocational rehabilitation services help eligible people with disabilities obtain, maintain or advance in employment.
- To be eligible for assistance from VR, a person must have a physical or mental impairment that constitutes a substantial impediment to employment AND require VR services to prepare for, secure, engage in, retain, advance in or regain employment.
- VR provides a wide range of services.
- A Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor will help the client determine which services are required to achieve employment.



## DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES

- The Division of Youth Services (DYS) is the state agency charged with the care and treatment of delinquent youth committed to its custody by one of the 45 Missouri juvenile courts.
- DYS programs are established to provide the mandated services enumerated in Chapter 219.016 in the Revised Statutes of the state of Missouri.
- These services include assessment, care and treatment, and education of all youth committed to its care.
- Toward this end, DYS operates <u>treatment programs</u> ranging from non- residential day treatment centers through secure residential institutions.
- Additionally, DYS administers the Interstate Compact on Juveniles, operates an accredited school program, and maintains a statewide statistical database of juvenile court referrals.



## BETTER FAMILY LIFE

#### **OUT OF SCHOOL YOUTH**

- Serves youth between the ages of 16-24 by providing information, training, and resources necessary to be successful in their career or educational pathway towards self-sufficiency.
- Youth are either school dropouts or high school/HISET graduates that are not employed or registered in a postsecondary or certification program.
- All youth must meet the classification of low income as determined by WIOA guidelines as directed by St. Louis County DHS/DWD and meet at least one of seven outlined barriers which are:
  - Not attending any school and between the ages of 16-24
  - Low income high school graduate, and is an individual who is basic skills deficient or an English language learner
  - Homeless, runaway, foster child, or aged out of foster system
  - Pregnant or parenting
  - Subject to the juvenile or adult justice system
  - Individual with a disability
  - Participants who need assistance to complete education programs to secure or hold employment



## ST. LOUIS YOUTH JOBS

- Youth are recruited from target neighborhoods where the program can make the greatest impact.
- Once a young person is identified, they receive assistance in articulating their dreams, interests, assets, and areas for greatest potential.
- They are paired with a job coach who is committed to their individual success, and where possible, they are matched with a job in their area of interest.
- Training and skills building are provided in the areas of:
  - Financial Literacy
  - Essential Skills
  - Job Readiness
- Youth are connected with employment experiences (the program pays their salary).
- A Job Coach provides the initial assessment, works with both the youth and employer throughout the duration of the program, and provides follow-up support to assist the youth in finding employment post-program.
